**DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD:**

**General Location:** The field is in the southwest corner of Vermont, about  
75 miles north from Bradley Airport in CT. 60 miles from Albany and 120  
miles from Boston's Logan Airport

**From Connecticut & Massachusetts:** 91North to exit 26, RT 2W  
towards Greenfield/North Adams. Next roundabout take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit onto  
Mohawk Trail – MA-2. Then make a right on the Shelburne Falls/Colrain  
Road after you pass an Antique Store on the right and Shelburne Coffee  
Roasters is on the left (this is a difficult turn to see – not well marked). The  
Shelburne Fall/Colrain road turns into MA 112 which takes you directly into  
Vermont. Then take a sharp left onto VT 100. Follow to school which is on  
the left after you ascend to the top of the steep hill.

**Alternately:** 91North into Vermont. Get off at the Brattleboro exit and  
follow Route 9W to 100S. The school is at the top of the hill on the right after  
passing through Jacksonville. This is more straight forward, but slightly less  
direct than the directions above.

**From New York:** RT 7 W to RT 9 W. Follow RT 8 S. Then take a left onto  
VT 100 toward Whitingham/Jacksonville. Follow VT 100 to school which  
will be down on the right.

**From Keene, NH:** RT 9 W to 100 S (Route 9W intersects directly with  
100S). Take straight to school.

### Eligible Breeds and Registry

Only purebred Afghans, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos (medio & grande), Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Thai Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds and Whippets, one year of age or older and that are registered with the AKC, or part of an AKC-registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside the USA and owned by a USA resident, or of a country with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and are registered with that registry, or have an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP), are eligible for an entry. Also eligible to participate: \*Sloughis one year of age or older that have been recorded with the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) or that have been granted an ILP are eligible to enter Tests but may participate in Trials on an Exhibition Only basis; sighthounds enrolled in AKC's FSS which are eligible to compete in Conformation Miscellaneous class; spayed and neutered hounds. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are not eligible to participate. Breed disqualifications apply.

### Tests Offered

**QUALIFYING COURSER:** Open to hounds that are at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. **This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake.**

**Junior Courser:** Open to all eligible sighthounds at least 12 months of age. A hound running alone must receive a certification from a Judge on one date, and a second certification from a different Judge at a later date, with each Judge stating that the hound completed a (minimum) 600-yard course with a minimum of 4 turns. The hound must complete the entire course with enthusiasm and without interruption. Ribbons (Dark Green) will be awarded to all hounds that successfully complete the course.

### Stakes Offered

**OPEN STAKE:** Any eligible sighthound that has an AKC Qualified Courser title (QC) only (no Field Champions) or has earned an AFSA/CKC Field Championship; with proof

**SPECIALS STAKE:** Any AKC Field Champion of Record.

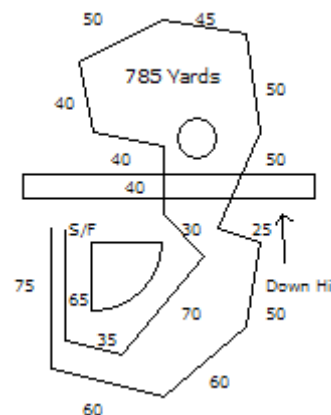
**OPEN VETERAN STAKE:** Open to any hound that is qualified to enter AKC lure trials. In addition, the hound must be at least 7 years of age on the day of the trial, except Borzoi, Greyhounds, and Scottish Deerhounds who must be at least 6 years of age, and Irish Wolfhounds, who must be at least 5 years of age. Championship points will be awarded.

**Best in Field Will Be Offered (Italian Greyhounds are NOT eligible)**

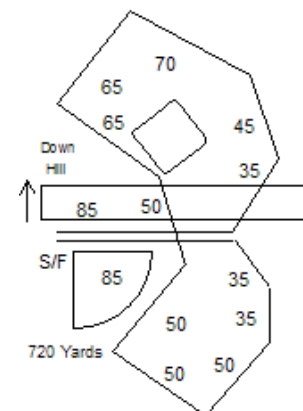
**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:** All Hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Hounds not present at time of Roll Call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available. The course will be reversed for the final courses. The members of NERRC reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.
