Eligible Breeds and Registry

Only purebred Afghans, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos (medio & grande), Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Thai Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds and Whippets, one year of age or older and that are registered with the AKC, or part of an AKC-registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside the USA and owned by a USA resident, or of a country with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and are registered with that registry, or have an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP), are eligible for an entry. Also eligible to participate: *Sloughis one year of age or older that have been recorded with the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) or that have been granted an ILP are eligible to enter Tests but may participate in Trials on an Exhibition Only basis; sighthounds enrolled in AKC's FSS which are eligible to compete in Conformation Miscellaneous class; spayed and neutered hounds. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are not eligible to participate. Breed disqualifications apply.

Stakes Offered

QUALIFYING COURSER: Open to hounds that are at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake.

OPEN STAKE: Any eligible sighthound that has an AKC Qualified Courser title (QC) only (no Field Champions) or has earned an AFSA/CKK Field Championship; with proof

.SPECIALS STAKE: Any AKC Field Champion of Record.

OPEN VETERAN STAKE: Open to any hound that is qualified to enter AKC lure trials. In addition, the hound must be at least 7 years of age on the day of the trial, except Borzoi, Greyhounds, and Scottish Deerhounds who must be at least 6 years of age, and Irish Wolfhounds, who must be at least 5 years of age. Championship points will be awarded.

SINGLE STAKES: A non-titling stake open to all sighthound breeds eligible to participate in AKC Lure Coursing trials.

Best in Field Will Be Offered (*Italian Greyhounds are NOT eligible*)

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: All Hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Hounds not present at time of Roll Call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic bags or strips. Backup equipment will be available. The course will be reversed for the final courses. The members of NERRC reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.

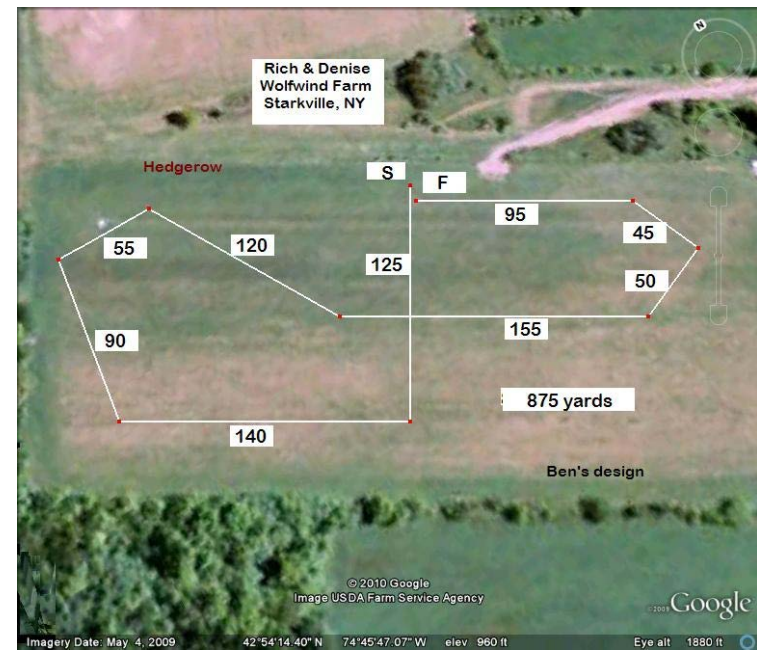
Saturday's JC/QC Course – 630 yards

place is the first farm on the right past the sheep pastures. [About 17 miles from Exit 30.]

FROM THE SOUTH (Binghamton area): Take Rt. 88 EAST to Exit 13 (Oneonta). Turn LEFT onto Rt. 205 NORTH – follow to State Route 80 NORTH. Follow SR 80 North through historic Cooperstown, continue for about 10 miles, cross through the intersection at State Rt. 20 (small gas station on the right). Continue on SR 80 North for about 9 miles (very curvy, hilly road), to the intersection of Rt. 168 – **Elwood Rd is the first RIGHT past Rt. 168**. Follow Elwood Rd 1.5 miles around and up the hill, our place is the first farm on the right past the fields. [About 55 miles from Exit 13]

(NOTE: There is a new Dunkin' Donuts at Exit 28 (mile marker 182—Fonda, Fultonville), as well as two truck stops with restaurants, a McDonald's, and several gas stations. The Travel Lodge is next to Dunkin Donuts. It's an easy-off, easy-on exit, and 12 miles from Exit 29, which is our exit.)

FROM THE EAST: New York State Thruway (I-90) to Exit 29 (mm 194 – Canajoharie, Sharon Springs, Fort Plain, Cooperstown, Oneonta, St. Johnsville). Pay the toll – the big white Beech Nut Foods factory will be on your right, a Getty station & small convenience store is on the left. Turn RIGHT at the stop sign onto State Route (SR) 5-S West.

Go through the little traffic light in Canajoharie, and continue on SR 5-S West for about 3 miles to the village of Fort Plain. You will drive across a small steel bridge over the canal (Getty station on the left) -- turn LEFT at that traffic light onto SR 80 South.

In two blocks there is a Valero gas station & Nice n' Easy convenience store on the left, if anyone needs to pick anything up (or use the restroom) – there is nothing else between Fort Plain and the house. Watch the speed limits, and make sure your seat belts are fastened (heavy fines up here).

Stay on SR 80 South for 7.9 miles – then watch for a 'Speed Zone Ahead' sign and a small painted sign on the right, Village of Starkville. Please slow down – there are often old dogs in the road around the bend. **Elwood Road (CR 74) is the first road on the LEFT immediately after the sign for SR 168**. (If you reach Rt. 168 on the right, you passed Elwood Rd.)

Turn LEFT onto Elwood, and continue for 1.5 miles – the road snakes left, then right, then straightens out (please watch for kittens, kids, dogs, and tractors). Continue up the hill (the road snakes again at the top). Pastures will be on both sides -- we're the first farmhouse on the RIGHT, after the pastures. You'll see the 4-board rail riding arena (with the yellow Guinea Fowl Xing sign), some tall spruce trees, and the house – white farmhouse, green trim and roofs, black mailbox #381, small circular drive. [About 13

Turn LEFT onto Elwood, and continue for 1.5 miles – the road snakes left, then right, then straightens out (please watch for kittens, kids, dogs, and tractors). Continue up the hill (the road snakes again at the top). Pastures will be on both sides -- we're the first farmhouse on the RIGHT, after the pastures. You'll see the 4-board rail riding arena (with the yellow Guinea Fowl Xing sign), some tall spruce trees, and the house – white farmhouse, green trim and roofs, black mailbox #381, small circular drive. [About 13 miles from Exit 29.] **Access to the field is via the new driveway immediately before the riding arena – signs will be posted.**

FROM THE WEST: New York State Thruway (I-90) East to Exit 30 (Herkimer). Pay the toll, turn LEFT at the traffic light, cross over the Mohawk River & Erie Canal bridge. Continue through that traffic light, turn LEFT at the next traffic light onto SR 28 South (Fastrac will be on your right after you make the turn – it's the last convenience store & gas station before the house). Continue south on SR 28 for about ¾ mile, then turn LEFT onto Rt. 168 (before the big hill). **Continue on Rt. 168 for about 15.3 miles (curvy, hilly road) – at the end, turn LEFT onto State Rt. 80, and immediately RIGHT onto Elwood Road**. Follow Elwood up the hill, our
