DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD:

From New York or New Haven:

(Best Direction)

I-95 North to I-395 (toward Norwich/Plainfield). Take Exit 85. At light, go straight across to second light. Take a right onto Rt. 138. Follow Rt. 138 for 4-5 miles and take a right onto Rt. 201 (Glasgo Rd.). Follow to stop sign (2-3 miles) and go across Rt. 165 and continue on Rt. 201 (Glasgo Rd.). Farm will be 1-2 miles down on your right, Sterry - Kinnie Farm. Signs will be posted.

(Alternative Direction)

I-95 North to Exit 92. At end of ramp, take a left onto Rt. 2 (Norwich Westerly Rd). Follow to rotary, go 1/2 way around and take a right, continuing on Rt. 2. Follow Rt. 2 and take a right, at a light, onto Rt. 201 (Cossaduck Hill Rd). Follow approximately 8 miles and Farm will be on your left, Sterry - Kinnie Farm. Signs will be posted.

From Boston or Providence:

I-95 South to Exit 92. Follow straight across and continue to light. Take a right onto Rt. 2 (Norwich Westerly Rd). Follow directions above for "From New York or New Haven (Alternative Direction)".

From I-395 Northbound:

Follow directions above for "From New York or New Haven (Best Direction)".

Eligible Breeds and Registry

Only purebred Azawakh, Afghans, Basenjis, Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos (Medino & Grande), Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Thai Ridgebacks and Whippets, one year of age or older and that are registered with the AKC, or part of an AKC-registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside the USA and owned by a USA resident, or of a country with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and are registered with that registry, or have an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP), are eligible for an entry. Also eligible to participate: sighthounds eligible to compete in Conformation Miscellaneous class are eligible to participate in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the prefix title of Field Champion and the suffix titles of Junior Course, Senior Courser, or Master Courser; spayed and neutered hounds.

Hounds may not be entered as "registration pending" or "ILP pending". Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are not eligible to participate. Breed disqualifications apply.

Stakes Offered

QUALIFYING COURSER: Open to hounds that are at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake.

JUNIOR COURSER: Open to all hounds of an eligible breed at least 12 months of age. A hound running alone shall receive a qualification from a judge at one event, and a second qualification from a different judge at a separate event, stating that the hound completed a 600 yard course with a minimum of four (4) turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

OPEN STAKE: Open to all hounds from eligible breeds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate (QC). This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from The American Sighthound Federation (ASFA) or The Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Championships must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title are not eligible to enter the **SPECIALS STAKE:** Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship title. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles.

VETERAN STAKE: Open to all hounds of an eligible breed that are eligible to enter Open or Specials Stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club—6 years of age; except Irish Wolfhounds = 5 years and Whippets = 7 years. Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent title.

Best in Field Will Be Offered (Italian Greyhounds are NOT eligible)

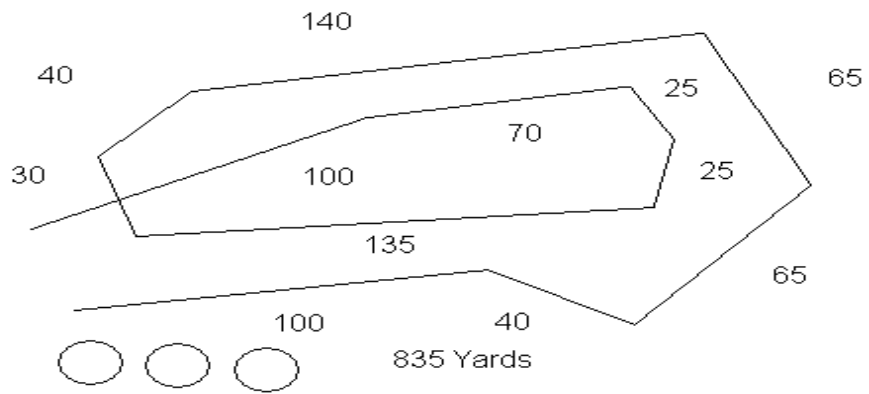
NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: All Hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Hounds not present at time of Roll Call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available. The course will be reversed for the final courses. The members of NERRC reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial. Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the field committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must be under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s) at all times. Early acceptance for roll call of hounds for trial/test workers may begin one-half hour prior to published trial/test hours.

There will be a \$5 fine assessed for any loose hound interrupting a course in progress.

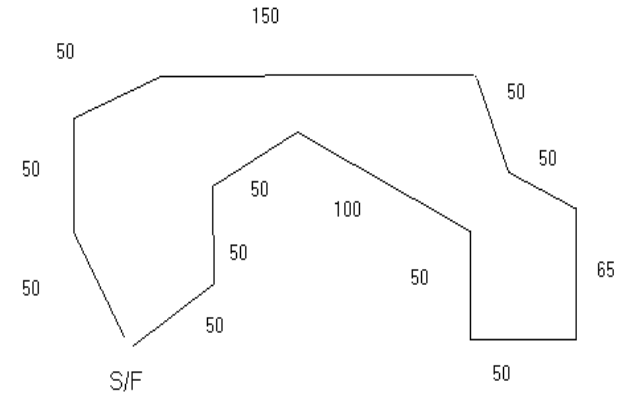
